

GUIDELINES FOR THE CORRECT ORDER FORM COMPLETION:

ROLLER-BLINDS ORDER – ANY DIMENSIONS

1. Mechanism type – put an „X" in the appropriate box.

- *MAXI* – roller-blinds with Ø26 or Ø32 tubes, depending on the blind's width. They are generally designed to be mounted on the wall or ceiling,
- *MINI*- roller-blinds with Ø19 tubes with fixtures for non-invasive installation directly on the casement; as a standard it is made with the uncovered, white weight, which is additionally fastened to the lower part of the pivoting casement with Velcro® fastener ,
- *SPRING* – spring mechanism roller-blind. In the column REMARKS, please specify the roller-blind type - „for roof window" or „wall-mounted" , it is made with self-braking spring.

2. Please specify only one of the required widths:

- a) total (incl. mechanism and brackets) - for roller-blinds to be installed within the limited space,
 - for roof window roller-blinds (separate guidelines),
- b) of the fabrics – for other instances.

The width of the fabric is smaller than the total width by ca. 5 cm (with MAXI mechanism) or by ca. 3,5 cm (with MINI mechanism). In case of roller-blinds with MINI mechanism for casement, the fabric should cover 1 cm of the window frame on each side of the window pane.

3. The maximum, problem-free for technological reasons, height of roller-blinds is 180 - 190 cm (depending on the fabric and weight type).

With heights exceeding 180 - 190 cm, please note the following limitations:

- a) In case of mono-colour and patterned (without specifically-oriented pattern) fabrics, the blind's height may be bigger, but its width cannot exceed 195 cm. When both dimensions are exceeded, the blind will

be made of two pieces of fabric fastened horizontally,

- b) In case of any roller-blind of the height more than 180 cm made from the fabrics with a specifically-oriented pattern, e.g. horizontally (B407, B310) in order to avoid the above mentioned fabric connection, we suggest making a roller-blind from one fabric piece as long as its width does not exceed 195 cm. The pattern will be then turned by 90° (it will be in a horizontal position). Please mark the acceptance of this solution in the REMARKS column - „*without joining the fabric*”.
- c) When ordering the roller-blind with the patterned fabric of the height exceeding 180 cm along with other blinds of the same fabric but of smaller heights (set: window + balcony door), please mark this in the REMARKS column - „*for one room* ”.

- 4. Write the colour number from the catalogue of the roller-blind fabrics.
- 5. Write the required quantity of the roller-blinds you are ordering.
- 6. Specify the sides of the roller-blind's control mechanisms (left or right, as view from inside the room).
- 7. **Weight type** - put an „X" in the appropriate box.

The possible finishes of the roller-blind:

- fabric-covered weight,
- uncovered weight – the blind's finish with a visible weight i.e. aluminium batten,
- blind with a frill – as a rule we sew a frill onto the roller-blind.

- 8. Also in the REMARKS column, it is necessary to mark the following:
 - a) additional „*frill with a batten*” attached to the uncovered, white weight,
 - b) additional fittings e.g. "*bottom fixtures*" for the fabric covered weight,
 - c) „*fabric further away from window*"- different direction of unrolling the fabric. All roller-blinds are made in the way that the fabric to be rolled up and down is „closer to the window".

The exception is the case of MAXI roller-blinds with standard dimensions, which are offered on stands in shops, where the fabric is „closer to the window". Such a remark must be made e.g. when ordering a roller-blind which is supposed to supplement another blind which was previously bought from a shop's stand (so they look identical afterwards).

- d) „*mounting with the original brackets* " – this refers to the roller-blinds for roof windows which are already equipped with the manufacturer's brackets.

Please read carefully these guidelines and fill in the order form accurately. The roller-blinds, which will be made according to the inaccurate data from your order form, will not be subject to any claims.
